The Bow Tie – The Defining Detail

There's one rule here: **always self-tie**. A pre-tied bow tie kills the elegance of the look. A properly tied bow has a slight asymmetry that shows effort, not perfection. A classic Black Tie look includes a bow tie in black silk, satin, or textured variations. If you're trying a more modern look, you could always try a gold, silver, or red bow tie – or even white.

Textured fabrics like grosgrain or velvet can add depth without straying from tradition.

Either way, make sure the width is in proportion to your face; nothing oversized, but nothing too tiny either.
