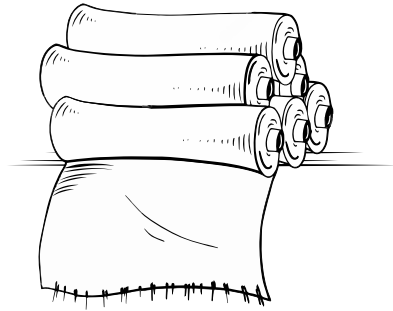

Of course, for the well-prepared gentlemen, you may want to start thinking about what styles and colours will suit you prior to this.

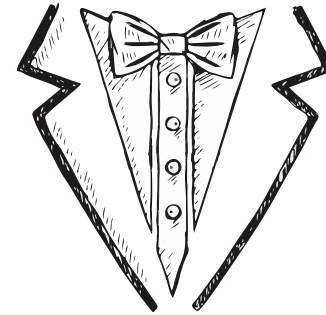

Ever bought an expensive off-the-rack suit & tie, only to find that it's just a little too tight on your calf, or bunches up slightly at the back of the neck?

After a while, you realise that the fit is slightly off, or the lining is uncomfortable, & it's just not flattering.

Many people are surprised to learn that tailor-made suits are not as expensive or time consuming to buy as they might think.

While the process to create great tailor-made suits can take time, the results are well worth your while.

So, what makes a tailor-made suit so special, & how does it differ from an off-the-rack suit & tie?

The perfect fit

Fit is the key difference. An off-the-rack suit is created from "standard sizes", meaning no allowance is made for variations in weight & body size. Men who are more athletic, or have a body shape a little out of the ordinary will struggle to make an off-the-rack suit fit, even with alterations.

The bespoke suit process

Off-the-rack suits offer very little control over style & fit. If you're lucky enough to have "regular" suit measurements, you might be able to get away with buying off-the-rack suits without making any significant alterations; but most men won't be able to get that "fits like a glove" comfort level.

Compared to this, a bespoke suit is created by a process of an initial fitting, followed by multiple fittings afterward.

At Woolcott St, we often take up to 50 different suit measurements for you, with multiple fittings.

The style, fit & fabric choice are all customisable.

When fitting you, we draw on years of training handed down from international master tailors to take extensive suit measurements, all the while taking into account your posture, build & unique requirements.

We'll also ask our clients questions about their lifestyle & needs & ensure that their garments fill these requirements. For instance, if you're taking long-haul business flights, you'll probably want a non-crease, breathable fabric, whereas if you're frequently traveling to colder climates, you might want warmer fabrics in a weightier cloth. You may only want to purchase a suit & tie for your summer wedding, in which case you'll want lightweight, breathable fabrics like linen in appropriate colours & styles.

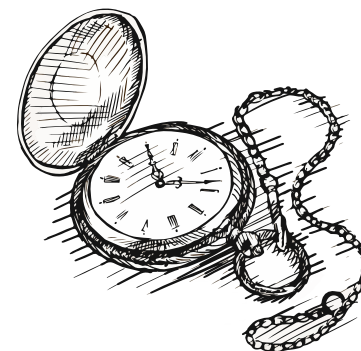

Styles and Dress Code

To avoid any major sartorial stumbles, ensure the dress code for your wedding is set from the start.

If you're attending a wedding, however, the dress code should be clearly stated on your wedding invitation, so all you have to do is dress appropriately (and show up, of course).

We cater to all different kinds of weddings & dress codes, from casual to classy, & we'll ensure that you look great whether you're attending or hosting.

Where do I begin?

If you're a wedding guest, take cues from your invitation.

A beach wedding isn't always casual, so don't assume.

The word "casual" in itself when it comes to weddings should be taken with a grain of salt (or sand, should we say?).

For instance, shorts are almost never appropriate at a wedding, even a "casual" wedding.

You can also take cues from the location. For example, is the wedding actually on the beach, or is it in a park or gazebo nearby? Is it going to be hosted in an old rustic barnyard? Also check the time, as this will dictate dress code. A night-time wedding usually necessitates a more formal dress code.



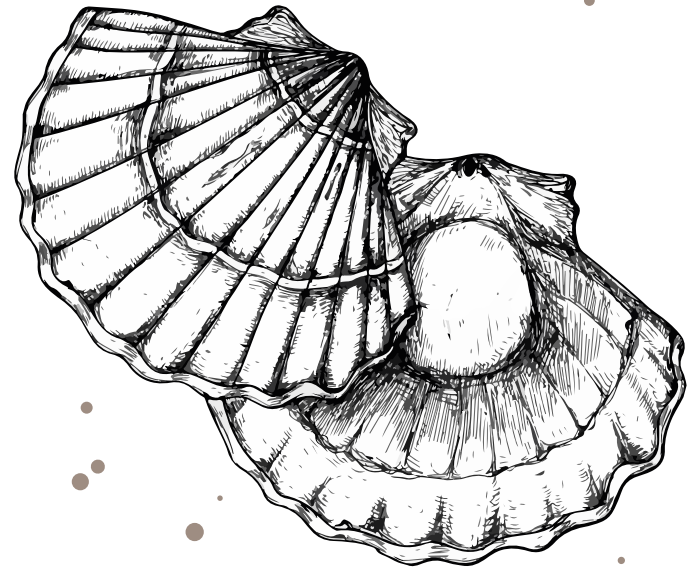
3 Most Popular WEDDING THEMES:

Casual Beach Wedding

A casual beach wedding isn't always as casual as it seems. It's still a wedding after all, so ensure you look the part. If the wedding is being held in a warmer climate, linen will be your go-to, as it will be breathable & cool on your skin in the hot sun.

Although casual, a beach wedding still calls for shirts, pants & possibly a blazer or sports coat of some kind. Depending on how warm it is, you can lose the blazer (& probably the shoes!) on the beach. And while there is no need to add a tie, you can still accessorise with small touches like a pocket square & a garland.

We recommend opting for a more relaxed linen pant, trouser or chino in a looser fit & light colour.



Garden Party Affair

Garden weddings usually fall under the “cocktail” category, but again, check your invitation & tailor your outfit to the dress code as well as the season.

In winter, you can get away with wearing heavier fabrics such as heavier wool blends or tweed. You may even want to add a top coat for added warmth.

A more “rustic”, country-style wedding can mean that browns & light grey colours feel more appropriate, whereas a wedding nearer the city can call for a navy or charcoal; anything that has a more modern feel. Earthy hues like burgundy or forest green can prove a winner in any setting, & a tasteful pinstripe never goes astray.

If you’re going bolder on the suit, stick to a neutral or block-coloured shirt, whereas you can get away with a bolder shirt if the suit is more neutral.

A tie is still a must in a cocktail scenario, adding cufflinks, watch, & a pocket square to add intrigue to your ensemble.





Black Tie Wedding

Black tie is a dress code that generally refers to formal events after 7pm & is likely to be the most formal dress code you'll ever have to abide by (unless you're a member of a royal family or off to galas every other week).

The truth is; black tie for men isn't hard to do, but, much the same as the classic suit & tie, the secret to doing it well is in the details; a perfectly shined shoe, the perfect fit, & high-quality pieces put together seamlessly.

Black tie for men generally means a tuxedo comprised of a dinner jacket; often black (or more recently, a deep midnight blue), trousers, formal white shirt, an optional waistcoat or cummerbund, bow tie & formal black shoes. A classic black dinner jacket is usually the norm, however, as per a regular suit & tie look, recent variations include burgundy, deep midnight blue, emerald green, white or even black.

Opt for simple fitted black trousers, & a shined black shoe.

Then you'll need a classic white dress shirt with a cummerbund or waistcoat. A shirt with black buttons can spice up a more classic look. A bow tie is a must for black tie events but a clip-on is a big fat no-no, unless you're sitting at the kids table.

If you're in doubt about the dress code, ask. If it's your own wedding, define the dress code clearly on the invitation, or you're bound to have at least a few anxiety-stricken wedding guests who don't know what to wear!

YOUR PERFECT FIT

Fitting different body shapes

At Woolcott St, we're committed to ensuring you have the perfect fit. The beauty of a bespoke suit lies in the fit; a properly-fitted bespoke suit seeks to accentuate your best attributes a smooth over any undesirable physical features.

Rather than changing your suit every six months to suit the trends, we create suits which are fashion-forward, yet long-lasting, designed specifically to fit you like a glove.

That way, you can dress your well-fitting suit up with bold accessories for something a little more seasonally-relevant, if you so choose. Unless you're a clone, your wedding party is likely going to be a mish-mash of different physical shapes.

We've all got that one tall friend, forever hitting his head on your car door, the token short friend who is constantly the butt of your jokes, & the gym buff who is ready to bust out of his shirt sleeves.

**SOME OF THE COMMON (OR NOT-SO-COMMON)
SHAPES WE SEE ARE...**



Slim

For a slimmer man, layering fabric can add some much-needed bulk to the frame. A narrow or standard lapel is best, as this is in line with the rest of the frame. Busy patterns like checks & weaves can also add bulk, as can padding in the jacket shoulders to broaden the frame.

Athletic

On the other hand, for more athletic men, any padding in the shoulders will add more bulk than is needed, so opt for soft, natural shoulders in the jacket. Ensure it is tapered in at the waist (to avoid looking like a block) & a bespoke suit is a must. Off-the-rack suits tend to assume that big shoulders also equal a bigger stomach; so unfortunately, athletic men will never be able to buy properly-fitted off the rack suits. Avoid peak lapels; this will broaden the chest more.

Tall

For tall men, the aim is to break up the space from head to toe, thereby making him appear a little shorter. Cuffed pants or sleeves should be avoided; this will make a tall man look like he outgrew his suit! Wearing separates & a belt can break up the frame, & patterns & a pocket square can also break up the additional space.

Short

For shorter men, the opposite is true; you want to create the appearance of one long line from head to toe, which means one colour & no separates. A shorter-cut jacket will elongate the leg, & a deep-v shaped, two-button jacket will create length down the front of the body.

Pinstripes & micro checks are a short man's friend; they'll create the illusion of length, & a tapered trouser with no break will also add length in the leg.

Large

For larger men, the key here is again, to create a long, lean line from head to toe. Start with a dark base like charcoal or navy. Pinstripes can also work wonders in slimming the figure down.

Again, a proper fit is key, as extra fabric will only add unnecessary weight. Simple, block-coloured shirts are best, then the tie can be a little bolder.

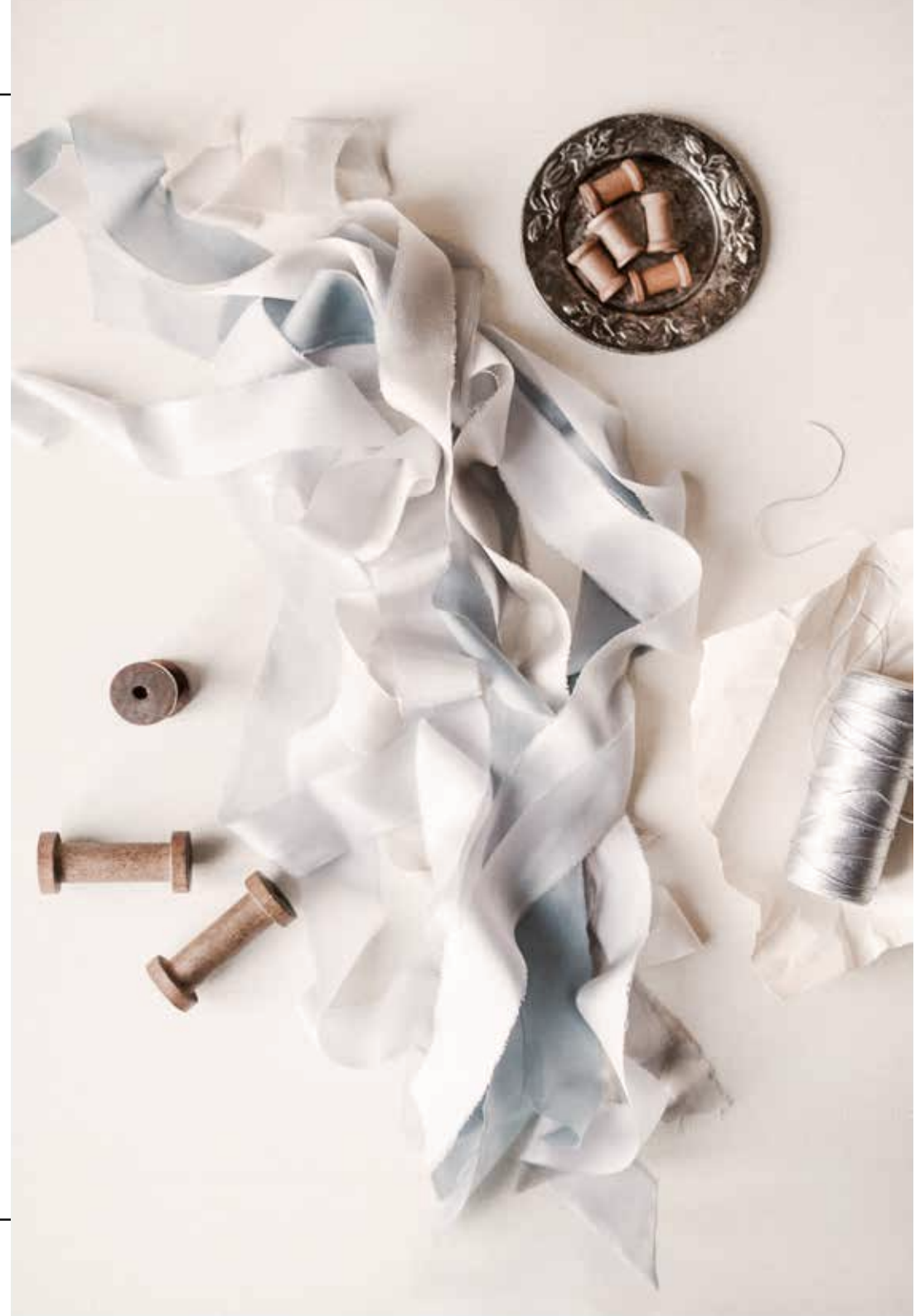
Discussing fabric choices

HAVING THE CORRECT FABRICS AT THE RIGHT TIMES OF YEAR WILL NOT ONLY MEAN THAT YOU'LL BE MUCH MORE COMFORTABLE ON YOUR BIG DAY, BUT YOUR GARMENTS WILL HAVE A MUCH LONGER SHELF-LIFE

So, what are the main suit fabrics we use, & how can you take advantage of their properties so you look & feel great come your big day?

WOOL

Even though Australian winters are mild compared to most European countries, you can dress for winter weddings with heavier-density wool suits and topcoats. The key to picking the right suit is the wool density. Some suits will be 100% wool & extremely dense, whereas others may be blended, or a lower-density fabric.



CASHMERE

While incredibly soft, cashmere is mostly used for topcoats & knits, however, a cashmere & wool-blended suit can be lovely & warm on your special day. Like wool, it's a natural fibre & allows the skin to breathe.

LINEN

For summer weddings, on the other hand, aim for lower-density wool fabrics or linens & cotton blends. Linen is a light, breathable fabric, however it does crease easily, which is why it's seen as more casual. It's also often blended with other, more sturdy fabrics so it keeps its shape better. Linen also dyes beautifully, which means you'll find it in a wide array of colours.

SILK

Silk on its own is very light, but silk-blended suits are an excellent, more formal alternative to other fabrics. Silk is another natural fabric (read: breathable) and, when blended with wool or mohair, it keeps its structure yet gives off a nice sheen.





ACCESSORIES

Complete your look

THE FINER DETAILS COULD BE THE JEWEL IN YOUR SARTORIAL CROWN; WHAT TAKES YOUR WEDDING DAY ATTIRE TO THE NEXT LEVEL. SO, IT MAKES SENSE TO PUT THAT EXTRA BIT OF THOUGHT INTO THE FINISHING TOUCHES.

Pocket squares, ties & bow ties.

Whatever your final wedding attire may be, some kind of tie or pocket square is a must. Even casual, no-tie wedding attire can be elevated with the use of pocket squares.

Vests

Vests or a three-piece suit & cufflinks can add the finishing touches to your special day. They are perfect for cooler weather & can help tie all the elements of your outfit together.

Overcoat

For winter weddings, an overcoat not only adds warmth, it adds another style dimension to your overall look. As long as you & your groomsmen aren't overly mismatched, overcoats can be a great idea, even if you're going to end up removing it on the dance floor later.

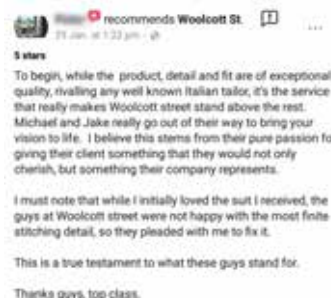
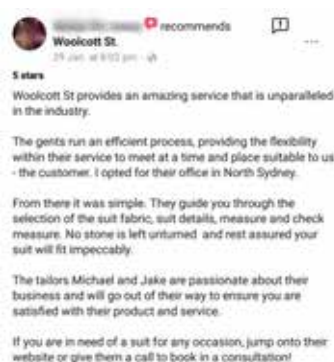
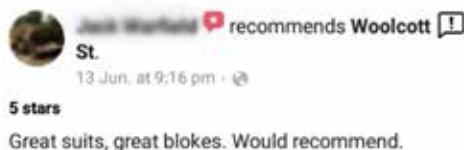
